Today's level of the impounded supply is 4.02m.

As I am sure everyone has noticed the new signage is starting to be seen around the district, more especially in the form of the flags that grace our streets. The simple 'Tararua Country' theme was chosen over more esoteric slogans on the basis that most people in New Zealand do not know where Tararua is. It was felt that the use of the name was paramount. Efforts to have weather forecasters and newsreaders use the Tararua name is also being encouraged.

I have been informed that the memorial clock on the Infracon building is presently in Napier where it is being fixed.

Colin Veale asked ScanPower some time ago to remove the sign on the Woodville Sports Stadium when they next have a cherry picker in town. They have been reminded in the last few days of this request. On inspection, either a new sign will be made or the existing sign repainted.

During the period of the Rugby World Cup the Council is happy for camper vans to park around Fountaine Square instead of the camping ground, if weather and ground conditions require the closure of the grass area. This does not include tents on the grass area of the park itself. Council will monitor numbers and provide additional rubbish bins if the need arises.
