

Renewal of manager's certificate

Checklist

If your Manager's Certificate has expired it cannot be renewed. You must make an application for a new Manager's Certificate. Indicative timeframe for processing this application is four-six weeks.

The following must be included with your application

- The completed, signed, and dated application form.
- Copy of Licence Controller Qualification Certificate.
- Copy of Licence Controller Qualification Bridging Test Completion Certificate.
- Photocopy of ID (*photo drivers licence, or passport, or HNZ 18+ card*).
- Only** if your certificate was issued or renewed outside of Tararua, submit a copy of your original manager's certificate or most recent renewed certificate.
- Manager's certificate fee: \$316.25 (*non-refundable*).
- This checklist.

The New Zealand Police are required by the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 to make enquiries into the suitability of the applicant. This will involve the Police informing the District Licensing Committee of any convictions or concerns involving the applicant. Should there be any concerns the applicant will also be informed.
