Recycling

Your 240L wheelie bin is for clean and rinsed type 1, 2, and 5 plastic bottles and containers, paper, cardboard, tin and aluminum cans.

National Solid Waste Standards now apply from 1 February, 2024.

New rules for kerbside recycling mean that we can no longer accept plastic or loose tin lids in our recycling facilities. This is due to size requirements:

To ensure your bin can be collected, please ensure the following items are not in your bin:



Glass

Your 45L crate is perfect for recycling glass bottles and jars that you aren't going to re-purpose or reuse.

For our teams safety please refrain from over filling, or putting any of the following items in the glass crate:

-  broken glass
-  windows or mirrors
-  light bulbs
-  bottle lids or corks








