

# SPECIAL LICENCE

41/SP/5888/2021

PURSUANT to Sections 22, and 64 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, Trevor Beale is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises known as "**Herbertville Fire Station**" and situated at 34 Seaview Road Dannevirke 4970 to any person attending the following occasion or event: fundraiser

Pursuant to Section 213(2) of the Act, the licensee is exempt from the requirement to appoint a certified Manager on the grounds that the Committee is satisfied that Phil Murphy and Trevor Beale, as nominated by the licensee, will be responsible for the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol pursuant to the Licence

## Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. The nominated person or a certified manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol
2. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Saturday 12 February 2022 3.00pm to 9.00pm**
3. Alcohol may be sold or supplied to the following types of people: **Ticket Holders**  
The whole (or each of the following parts) of the premises is designated as a supervised area: Bar area
4. The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - a. Display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the sale of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons
  - b. Photo identification is required to be produced by the patron when staff are in doubt of a patrons age
5. Drinking water must be freely available at the following places while the premises is open for business: **Every bar at all times while Alcohol is being sold and supplied**
6. Food must be available for consumption on the premises **at all times while Alcohol is being sold and supplied**
7. Low alcohol and non alcoholic beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises **at all times while Alcohol is being sold and supplied.**
8. The licensee must provide take the following steps to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises as follows: **Signage relating to transport options.**

## Duration

This licence is issued for the listed date and time of each event above, only.

This licence is in force until **13 February 2022.**

**DECISION**

**Authority**

The functions, powers and duties as the District Licensing Committee is delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and Inspector, in respect of the following applications:

- an application for a licence;
- an application for a manager’s certificate;
- an application for renewal of a licence or manager’s certificate.

**Statutory Provisions**

- Section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012
- Council resolution dated 23 November 2013;
- There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place.

**Summary of Evidence**

Reports from Police, the Medical Officer of Health and the Inspector appointed under the Act do not oppose the issue of a licence. Based on the information provided to me on the complete file, I have determined not to convene public hearings.

**Mangement of Special Licence**

An exemption under Section 213(2) of the Act has been sought by the applicant and is recommended by the Inspector. I am satisfied that a responsible person can effectively manage this event and an exemption is granted.

## **Evaluation of Evidence**

I have considered the application and have had regard to Section 4 of the Act, being the Object of the Act and have had regard to Section 142 of the Act, being the criteria for issue of of Special Licences.

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received where no objections have been raised. I therefore conclude there is no reason not to grant this application.

## **Decision and Reasons**

All reports are satisfactory and no objections have been raised to the granting of this application.

Therefore I determine that this application for a Special Licence be granted.

The licence may be issued immediately to Trevor Beale, the applicant.
