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Kia ora

I am writing in response to your official information request dated 11 September 2026 regarding No Spray Zone marker posts.

Council's response is set out below.

1. What does a No Spray Zone peg look like, including dimensions and a picture?



Council's no spray zones are generally identified by an orange marker post displaying the words "No Spray Zone". The installation of these markers are managed by Council's spray contractor and recorded in Council's asset management system.

Council has been provided with a supplier example of the type of marker post used. A copy is attached for reference.

Council does not hold information readily identifying the dimensions of the marker posts used for no spray zones. However, information published by a supplier for a similar product indicates it is approximately 1.3 metres long, with about 900 mm visible above ground once installed. This information comes from the supplier and is

provided for reference only.

2. Where are the pegs sourced from and what do they cost?

Council holds information that these marker posts are sourced through road industry suppliers. Examples identified by Council's contractor include Traffic Signs NZ and RTL.

Council does not hold information identifying a single standard cost for these marker posts, as the price varies depending on the supplier, quantity ordered and commercial arrangements.

To assist with your request, Council's contractor identified publicly available supplier pricing for similar marker posts. One supplier advertises a price of approximately \$16.75 per post, while other suppliers require purchasers to request a quote. Actual purchase prices may vary from these advertised amounts.
