Kia ora

I refer to your official information request dated 18 September 2025 relating to street sweeping in Woodville.

In response to your request, officers advise that the street sweeping frequency varies based on the street. In Woodville, the State Highway, around the Fountaine Square and Upper Mclean Street are swept weekly and the other roads vary between monthly or manual sweeping only due to access.

The purpose of sweeping is to collect not just leaves but also other road debris that will build up in the kerb and channel. If the kerb and channels aren't cleaned regularly enough, then the debris build up will be too much for the sweeper truck to collect and this will then require a more expensive option.

In Autumn when we have high leaf fall, additional sweeps to the standard frequencies mentioned above are required.

With regard to costs, the total cost for the 2024/25 financial year for the whole Tararua District was:

- Local roads \$216,061.37
- State Highway \$95,727.26

Officers advise that following on from your enquiry, they have asked the team to review the frequencies across all towns to ensure they are still correct. If any changes to street sweeping frequency are required after this review, they will report this through to the Council.
