





# MAYORS TASKFORCE FOR JOBS

The Mayors Taskforce For Jobs (MTFJ) is a nationwide network of New Zealand's Mayors, working together towards the vision of all young people under 25 being engaged in appropriate education, training, work or other positive activity in their communities.

MTFJ has developed the Industry Partnerships - MTFJ community Employment Programme in collaboration with the Ministry of Social Development (MSD). As part of the programme, MTFJ will provide the Tararua District Council with funding to enable them to support rangatahi into sustainable employment. (30 hrs per week).

### OUR CRITERIA:

- → NEETs Not in Education, Employment or Training
- → Those clearly identified as at risk of becoming a NEET
- → Disabled youth (Medical certificate required)
- → Other youth aged 16-24

People of any age who are disadvantaged in the labour market who are not able to readily access MSD products and services.

As the Mayors Taskforce Coordinator for Tararua I work in collaboration with Tararua REAP, Tararua Community Youth Services, both our local iwi and the local MSD Work Brokers to connect local talent to local employers. The funding has been utilised to deliver work ready programs for youth, work with employers to identify skills gaps in their workforce, and find solutions to plug these gaps.

Mayors Taskforce for Jobs is able to provide flexible funding that ensures our approach is individualised for each employer and young person, helping break down the barriers often faced when entering the workforce. Since August 2020, the programme has successfully supported rangatahi into employment and funded local employers to cover costs such as:

- Recruitment cost
- Industry training
- Safety equipment
- Tools of Trade
- → Transport
- Pastoral Care
- Personal Protective Equipment

Employers that accessed Mayors Taskforce funding are encouraged to use the funds granted to them to support other local businesses when purchasing PPE gear or Trade tools and equipment whenever possible. This request has created fantastic support for many small businesses in our region.
