I refer to your official information request dated 29 April 2025 for information on mobility parking spaces.

Our response is outlined below.

1. The total number of designated mobility (disability) parking spaces managed by your council on public land.

Response: we have a total of 50 mobility parks in the Tararua District that the Tararua District Council manages. In addition there are 39 operation mobility spaces on private land that we are aware of. These are not managed by the Council.

Response: the operation mobility parking spaces that were created during the Pahiatua Main Street upgrade undertaken in recent years were designed by an engineer and upon review for this information request, appear to be in line with the standard. The older operation mobility parking spaces appear to not be in line with the standard, however some of them can be brought into specification with signage, or making flat to the curb / footpath.

5. Any policies, plans, or guidance documents your council uses when creating or maintaining mobility parking spaces.

Response: The standard will be followed with all new operational mobility parking spaces created, and a programme will be discussed by the roading asset managers on a way forward with regard to bringing the existing parks up to specification. Ngā mihi
