For your request about the rates paid over the past ten years for water supply, sewage, and stormwater services at 86 and 86A Tyndall Street, Pahiatua:

Please check your rates invoices. Each invoice includes a breakdown of charges on the reverse side, showing the amounts for each service.

Key points from that page:

District Water and Wastewater Charges: Once a property is connected to Council's water or wastewater system, full rates apply for each connection—even if no dwelling has been built. Properties with metered water are charged based on usage instead.

Service Connections: Only Council-approved contractors may carry out work on the district's water, wastewater, and stormwater networks. Private contractors are not permitted unless prior approval is granted.

The legal authority for charging rates is the Local Government (Rating) Act 2002. If a property is not connected but can be connected, a partial charge applies.

As noted in your email of 31 October 2025, your properties at 86 and 86A Tyndall Street are connected to these services. Rates are therefore charged accordingly.. Ngā mihi
